
IBDP Spanish B Teacher to Teacher Tips

How closely are the questions aligned with those of IB examinations?

Kognity works with IBDP examiners to write both the content for the textbook and the questions. This ensures that the questions included are written in the same manner as past paper questions, while also providing new questions for students to practice.







When students use the Kognity textbook, how can I keep track of their progress?

All student activity within Kognity is tracked and can be viewed by teachers. When you issue an assignment, you will be able to view all student data such as student answers, who has and has not submitted, and how long it took students to complete. You can also identify class trends that allow you to monitor student progress and adapt teaching accordingly. From the insights section, you can view the sections of the textbook that specific students have opened and/or completed and how they responded to the section questions, as well as an overview of self-directed learning that students have undertaken in the practice centre.
